



The Maple Festival Judging committee is planning on holding the annual Maple Syrup Contest this year. The contest will be run the same as in the past.

In the meantime we look forward to getting your samples and we hope everyone has a great sugar season!

Entrants can enter one sample of 2025 maple syrup in each of the three classes listed below. Only one entry per grade per sugarbush will be accepted.

Grade A: Golden Color and Delicate Taste

Grade A: Amber Color and Rich Taste

Grade A: Dark Color and Robust Taste

The Syrup samples will be judged according to class by the standards set by IMSI. Density and Clarity will be judged as in the past, with 66.7 the optimal density. If a sample does not meet density and color requirements for the class, it will be disqualified and not judged further. This is similar to the IMSI contests.

Hobby (200 taps and less) and Novice Producers will enter an 8oz sample for each class. Jars are available for free at Richards Maple Products and Seldom Seen Farm

Novice Producers (those that have produced less than 5 years) will be judged and scored but no awards given. This is a training class to help new producers get started. We encourage all smaller producers to enter the Hobby Class as soon as they feel they are ready to compete for prizes. First year Producers **CAN** enter the Hobby Class. You do not need to enter Novice.

Gauga County Producers (syrup makers with over 200 taps) and Out of County Producers can enter a one quart sample of 2025 Maple Syrup in each of the three grades.

Out of County Producer will be awarded based on points consisting of all three grades as awards 1-7
